TRAINING OVERVIEW



The Mainstreaming Children with Cerebral Palsy workshop, Cohort 12 held on 13th January 2024.

It was attended by 14 participants ranging from General Education Teachers, School Owners, and Parents across Lagos and Ogun state, Nigeria.

This year's training was facilitated by Ms. Shukrah Famuyiwa, Tobiloba Ajayi of The Let Cerebral Palsy Kids Learn Foundation, and Ms Rhoda Odigbo of The Learning Craft.

The Participants were exposed to various aspects ranging from the types of Cerebral Palsy and its manifestations, Basics of Inclusive Education, and Simple Technologies that can promote Inclusive Education among other things.

The participants got exposed to how to practice Inclusive Education the right way, how to design an effective Individualized Educational Plan, and how to manage Stigma and Discrimination.

Their reviews at the end of the training gave a renewed sense of hope for the Inclusive Education system in Nigeria.

The major highlight of the day was the practical session on Universal Design for Learning. The participants learned how to design lessons to accommodate different learning styles of all children in the classroom.
